

This is from the crime analyst.

First, service calls are those calls that are not criminal in nature. They can vary from informational reports, welfare checks, assist other agency. In the case of the Greywall subdivision, it was mainly assist other agency (24); Building check, lock out, foot patrol, attempt to locate, found property, station information, crisis intervention (16); citizen assist; crime prevention; welfare check (5)

Second, it is important to note that calls for service does not measure crime. Instead, it measures the amount of demand for police services in an area. In general, about 20~30% of calls for service end up having reports written. An even fewer number are criminal [related] reports. Of the 67 disturbance calls, only 2 generated reports (suspicious incident, not criminal). There were also 10 abandoned vehicles tagged, although some may be duplicates.

There were two burglaries reported last year, one in January and one in July. Overall, burglaries were down citywide in 2020. They were slightly higher than 2019, but both years reflect a huge decrease over previous years. The January burglary looks like it was related to partygoers from a few days earlier. The July burglary involved a foreclosed home and items that may have been left in the home.

There are no indications of robberies, shootings, drug arrests or any violent crime in Greywall in 2020.

The disorderly conduct calls involved 911 hang-ups, and none resulted in reports.

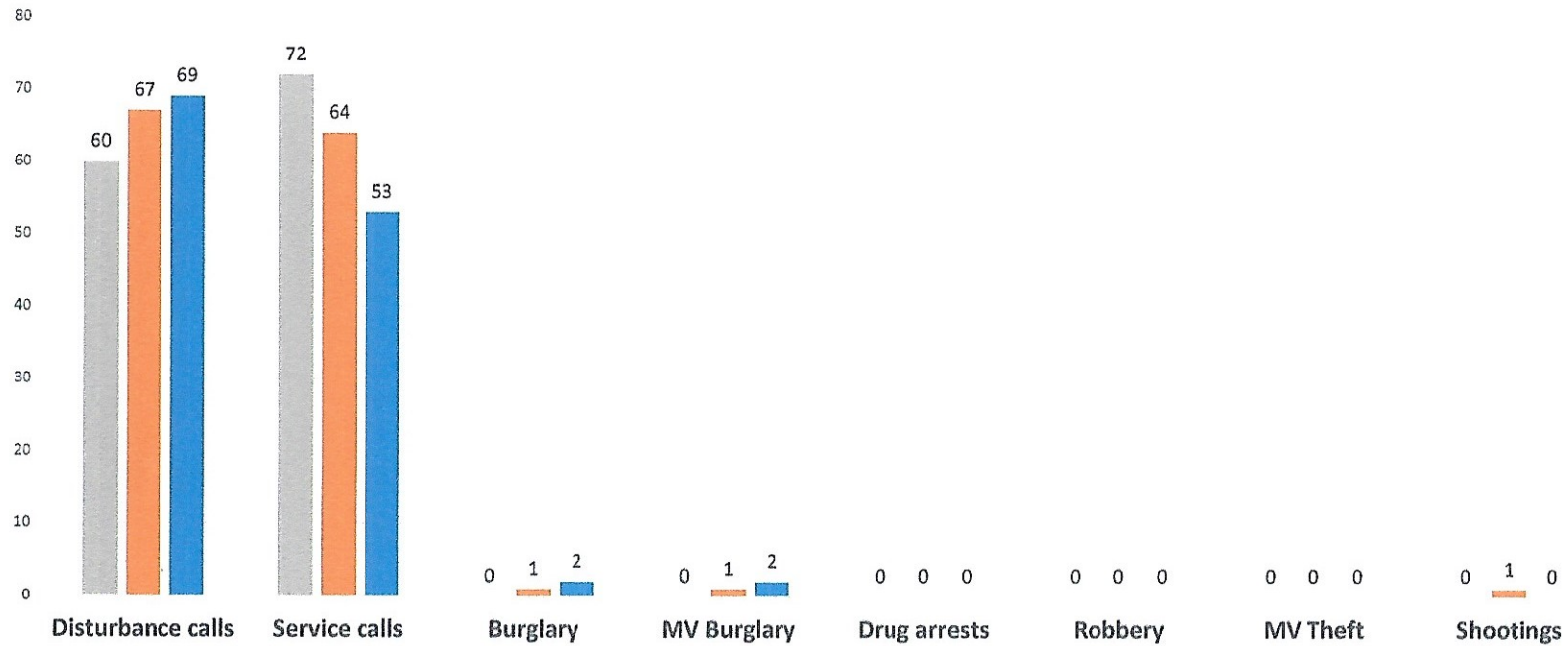
There were two reported Burglary to Motor vehicle in 2020, in August. Both occurred on the same block to unsecured vehicles during the same time period. For Federal reporting purposes, these two incidents were combined into one. The remaining call for BMV did not result in a report.

I do not see any reports for stolen political signs or eggs on garages.

In terms of comparison numbers, they do not change much in 2018 and 2019.
